| Science | Same as recommended | Three Credits: must include Biology, and two from: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Integrated Physics and Chemistry • Chemistry • Physics or Principles of Technology | Three Credits: Must include Biology and IPC (Physics and Chemistry may be substituted for IPC) |
| Social Studies | Same as recommended | Three and One-half Credits: World Geography, World History, U.S. History, Government (1/2) | Same as recommended |
| Economics | Same as recommended | One-half Credit | Same as recommended |
| Languages Other Than English | Three credits: Must be in the same language | Two Credits: Must consist of level I and Level II in the same language. | |
| Physical Education | Same as recommended | One and one-half Credits: must include Foundations of Personal Fitness (1/2 credit). Limit of two credits in PE can count toward graduation. Can substitute: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drill team • Marching band • Cheerleading • Dance I-IV • Athletics • 2 or 3 credit Career & Technology work-based training programs | Same as recommended |
| Health Education | Same as recommended | One-half Credit: Health Education or Health Science Technology (1 credit) | Same as recommended |
