### **Child Development -7143**

**Credit:** ½

**Grade:** 10-12

Prerequisite: *None*

This course is designed to provide individuals opportunities to develop knowledge and skills related to the development, care, guidance, and protection of children. Instruction addresses the principles and procedures for promoting the physical, emotional, social, and intellectual development of young children, including those with special needs.

Topics include career options related to the care and education of children. This course provides students with a basis for those seeking careers in early children education or careers in social work.

### **Ready, Set, Teach! I and II – 7141, 7142**

**Credit:** 2 [Lab based]

**Grade:** 11-12

Prerequisite: *Teacher approval and application*

This is a field-based internship, which provides students with background knowledge of child and adolescent development as well as principles of effective teaching practices. Students work in joint direction and supervision of both classroom teacher and teachers in rotation settings giving student experiences in a range of educational career roles, subject areas and ability groups.
