### **Business Education**

#### **Accounting I - 7121**

**Credit: 1**

**Grade: 11-12**

Prerequisite: *None*

This is an entry-level course designed to provide the fundamental concepts of accounting. This course is a good foundation for all students wishing to enter any business field. For student with a determined career objective in accounting or any business-related field, this course will provide students with experience for post-secondary level course work. **Grade: 11-12**

#### **Personal Finance/Consumer & Family Economics 7234**

**Credit: ½**

**Grade: 10-12**
