

Spelling Triple Try

Using word processing to practice spelling

Objective

- The students will practice spelling words

Technology Skills

- Keyboarding
- Creating columns

TEKS

5.17 spells proficiently

Duration

1- 20-minute class

Prerequisite for Teacher

- Creating columns
- Use of projector in computer lab

Prerequisite for student

- Creating columns

Before Computer Lab - teacher

- Develop list of spelling words and save into folder

Procedure

1. Students should open a word processing document and save it as Triple Try.
2. Create three columns with the document and save again.
3. Teacher then reads spelling words one by one (just like a pretest). As the teacher reads each word, the students number it and type the word.
4. Once the teacher has read all the words, the students then correctly spell the words in the second column, using spell check on the computer or using the list provided by the teacher on the projection screen.
5. When the students have completed the second column, they then spell the words correctly in the third column.
6. Once completed, they save their work and print it.

Assessment

- Completed Triple Try paper

Adaptation

- Use vocabulary from any subject to review

Extension

- Students print out the sheet after correctly spelling the words in the second column then use the paper to illustrate the word in the third column.

Modifications

- Work in partners
- Reduce the number of correctly spelled words required
