

Where We Live?

Slide Show -2nd Grade-Lesson

Objective

- The students will create a slide show explaining where they live (city, state, country, continent, and world).

Technology Skills

- Familiarization with KidPix 3, slide shows, and drawing tools

TEKS

- 2.6B Locate community, state, U.S., and selected countries on maps

Duration of Lesson

- Two or Three 45 minutes sessions

Prerequisite for Teachers

- Must be familiar with basic slide show skills using KidPix 3

Prerequisite for Students

- Basic slide show skills using KidPix 3 skills, saving documents using KidPix 3

Before the Computer (Teachers)

- Introduce how students live in a home, in a city, in a state, etc.

Before the Computer (Students)

- Students will have prior knowledge of where they live.

Procedure

1. Use the projector in the computer lab or the presentation stations in classrooms to demonstrate how you want the slide show set up.
2. You should have a page for each location and a title page.
3. Students will create each page and save to their folder.
4. Once each page is complete the students can begin their slide show.
5. Students will save the completed slide show to their folder.

Assessment

- Assess each slide show for the inclusion of all parts required and their accuracy.

Adaptation Ideas

- Students can create a slide show comparing different types of transportation.

Extension Ideas

- Have the students record their own voice on their slide show. Students can elaborate on each page.

Modification Ideas

- Have these students only work on one page. You can combine the pages to complete a class slide show. Students can also work with a partner or someone who has already completed their slide show.
